ICAR-Indian Institute of Wheat and Barley Research, Karnal calls for award applications to recognize Best AICRP Center (funded and voluntary) under All India Coordinated Research Project on Wheat and Barley for the year 2024. This activity of AICRP is aimed at encouraging healthy competition among AICRP centers (including voluntary enters).

Eligibility criterion: Funded AICRP centers and voluntary centers approved under All India Coordinated Research Project on Wheat and Barley.

Number of Awards: 02

1. Best AICRP funded center
2. Best AICRP voluntary center

Cooling Period: In view of variable strength and contributions, and to give chance to all, the institution bestowed with the best center award will have the cooling period of five years.

Application process: Interested institutions/universities need to submit information under the following heads for the achievements made during the last three years (2021-22 to 2023-2024).

Trial Conduction: <i>AICRP Trial Allocation, conduction and reporting, with no rejection of data since last three years except environmental factor.</i>	30 marks
Monitoring team report <i>Monitoring team report and their evaluation will be taken into consideration. Mainly will cover the quality of experimentation (including following strictly to sowing plan, field data recording and plant protection measures of the field, etc.)</i>	5 marks
Varieties / Genetic Stocks development <i>Variety released: Variety CVRC (6.0 marks) 2.0 marks/variety; Variety SVRC (4.0 marks) 1.0 mark/variety; Genetic stock registered (5.0 marks) 1.0 mark/genetic stock Promotion of entries: (5.0 marks) 1.0 mark/promoted entry Technology published in package of practices: (5.0 marks) 1.0 mark/technology</i>	25 marks
Publications <i>1 mark/research paper for >7.0 NAAS rating, 0.5 mark/research paper with NAAS rating <7 and >5.0, Best 10 Research papers made by scientists as First or Corresponding Author of the AICRP center will only be considered (Maximum 10.0 marks). Other publications (review article in NAAS rated journal/book chapter in books with ISBN): 0.5 mark/publication. Publications only on Wheat and Barley will be considered (Maximum 5.0 marks).</i>	15 marks
Seed production <i>Targeted and achieved seed production: 200-500 q production – 1 mark, 501-1000 q – 1.5 mark, 1001-2500 q – 2.5 marks, > 2500 q seed production – 5.0 marks each year</i>	10 marks
Extension activities <i>Successful execution of targeted FLDs/TSPs (Maximum 1.5 marks): 0.5 marks per other extension activities like farmers' training, Kisan mela, radio talk, etc. (Maximum 3.5 marks).</i>	5 marks
Financial compliance	5 marks

<i>Funds utilization and Timely submission of AUC: expenditure 90-95%- 1.0 mark, 95-99%- 1.5 marks, 99.1-100 % 2.5 marks each year (Maximum 5.0 marks)</i>	
Peer Recognition to any AICRP scientist at state or national level <i>1 mark per International or national recognition and Award; 0.5 mark per state recognition or award</i>	5 marks

Selection process: The interested AICRP centers will submit its duly filled application through email to director.iwbr@icar.gov.in on or before 04th of August 2024 after approval from competent authority. All the information provided should be supported by the authentic documents. A committee having experts from outside IIWBR will review the proposals and recommend nominations for award. The award will be presented during the forthcoming All India Wheat and Barley Research Workers' Meet.
